## SNAKE IN THE GUTTER

Number of Students: Six or more

How the game is played:

- Depending on the number of students, pick at least three kids to be "snakes." Have the snakes form the 'gutter' by standing in the line with wide spaces between them, facing the rest of the students, who should be at a distance. The adult in charge yells, "Snake in the gutter!" The children attempt to run through the gutter without being tagged by a snake. Those who get tagged are now snakes and stay in the gutter. Those who make it through can make another run through the gutter, but anyone who is tagged must join the snakes. Continue the game until everyone has been caught.

What the game teaches: Agility, problem-solving
