
UNDERSTANDING YOUR CHILD'S SOL REPORT



Lexile measures the place of a student's reading level and difficulty of text on a single scale and are correlated to grades 3-8 Standards of Learning (SOL) reading test scores. Lexiles may be used to help select books likely to improve students' reading and comprehension skills. Students may be comfortable reading books 100L below to 50L above their Lexile measure. Note that Lexile measures do not address the content or age-appropriateness of a book; the age and interests of the reader and the content of the book must be considered.
